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## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing ParaGrafix's photoetch set for the Fine Molds 1/72 scale Millennium Falcon kit. This set is intended for modelers of moderate ability and is definitely not for novices. Some prior experience with photoetched enhancements will be useful.

#### Materials

In addition to the photoetch, you will also need scissors or a knife\* to remove individual pieces from the main fret, a file to remove material left from cutting, and super glue (aka CA or cyanoacrylate). Additionally, to fold some pieces, you will need a pair of razor blades\*\* or a specialty tool such as PhotoFold from ParaGrafix

\* We prefer a #17 Xacto chisel blade.

\*\* Extreme care must be taken when using razor blades. Risk of serious injury.

#### Lighting Options


wise noted, you can prep areas for lighting by removing plastic from areas where there are through holes in the photoetch. You can then backlight the Unless othe photoetch. For best results, we suggest using Micro Kristal Klear from Microscale Industries (www.microscale.com) to fill the through holes. MKK can be tinted for different colored lights.


### Installation Parts Order









